"While the crowd pressed in around him to hear the word of God, Jesus, standing by the Sea of Galilee, saw two boats on the shore. The fishermen had got out of them and were washing their nets. He got into one of the boats, which was Simon's, and asked him to pull away a little from the land. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.

When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, 'Go out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch.' Simon answered, 'Master, we toiled all night and took nothing! But at your word, I will let down the nets.' And when they had done this, they enclosed a large number of fish, and their nets were breaking."

7"Then they signaled to their companions in the other boat to come and help them. They came, and both boats were filled to the point of nearly sinking. 8 Upon seeing this, Simon Peter fell to his knees before Jesus, saying, 'Lord, depart from me, for I am a sinner.' 9 For astonishment had seized him and all who were with him at the catch of fish they had taken, 10 and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. Jesus said to Simon, 'Do not be afraid; from now on you will be a fisher of men.' 11 And when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed him."
